
# **Embedded Image Scanner Quick Guide**

#### **Notice**

- The operating voltage of the scanner is 5V. Before connecting the scanner to the device, carefully check the rated voltage of the power supply.
- A standard packing includes a scanner, a cable(USB or RS232) and a quick guide.
- Use a piece of dry and soft cloth when cleaning the scanner is in need.

# Reading techniques

- 1. Press and hold the SCAN, the scanner projects a red LED square which allows positioning the barcode within its field of view, and turns on the white LED for illumination.
- 2. When reading a barcode, the red LED square will be smaller when the scanner is closer to the barcode and larger when it is farther from the barcode. Please hold the scanner at an appropriate distance from the barcode, and center the red LED square on the barcode.
- 3. On a successful barcode reading, the scanner will beep once, and the red LED square and white LED will be turned off. Then the scanner transmits barcode message to the host.




